1. UDC Student Code of Conduct

Behavioral expectations

Students are expected to comply with University protocols and policies during this period of the coronavirus virus (COVID-19), including, but not limited to:

- Completing the health screening each day before coming onto campus.
- Following University COVID-19 protocols as outlined on the RISE website.
- Always wearing a mask when in public spaces on campus.
- Maintaining a physical distance of not less than six feet from others when on campus.
- Complying with signage regarding directional hallways, elevators, shared spaces, and stairwells.

2. Syllabus language (recommended)

COVID-19 Compliance – All students will be required to wear a face mask in University buildings, including classrooms. You **MUST** wear a mask appropriately (i.e., covering both your mouth and nose) in the building if you are attending class in-person. The University policy requires students to complete a health screening (via LiveSafe) before coming to campus. If cleared, they must also wear a wristband, which indicates they are approved to be in your classroom, lab, or studio for the day. Please check for wristbands.

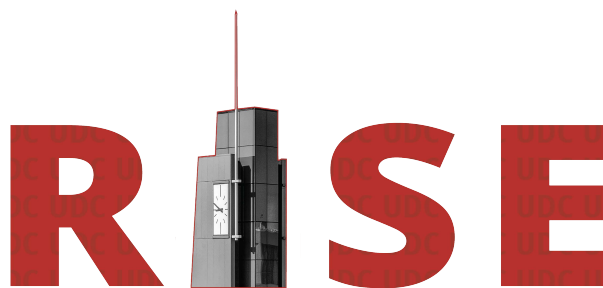
3. Steps to deal with non-compliant students

- Ask the student to comply with the COVID-19 safety requirements—always wear a mask!
- Remind the student that noncompliance violates the Student Code of Conduct. If a student complies, treat it as a warning.
- If the student refuses to comply, ask the student to leave the room immediately.
- If the student fails to comply or leave the room:
 - Dismiss class or activity
 - Call Campus Police at 202-274-5050
 - File a report with the Office of Judicial Affairs

In the event of an emergency, call Campus Police at 202-274-5050.
